Navigating Family and Ministry

HOW HAVE YOU FELT NAVIGATING FAMILY AND MINISTRY?

- Jonathan had to adapt and learn.
- Ministry is unique. You can't check out.
- Include all kids in ministry
 - Let ministry have a seat at the table.
 - Treat it as one of the children.
 - Jonathan gave up trying to find balance and leaned more into the Lord
 - The Lord works it out so people don't feel neglected or not valued.
 - As parents spend more time with the Lord, our words carry more weight.
 - God makes our words effective to the children.
 - Celebrate ministry and ministry celebrates you.
- The same rub of tension happens if you're in church or if you aren't.
- Be intentional to point out the wins/opportunities because of being in ministry.

- Find your child's love language.
 - Connect it in ministry.
- Let kids learn how to celebrate when one gets something and the others don't.
 - People who get jealous believe God doesn't have something for them.
 - Knowing that God has something for you so you don't have to be bothered with what others get.
- Point out to kids how they are acting/being like Jesus.
 - Show kids the impact they have on the body of Christ because of their sacrifices.
 - Let them share in the fruit.
- Learn to raise them to conduct themselves in public.
 - Practice what you want from your children.
 - Raise your children so they can be a part of the journey with you.
- You'll never discipline wrong if you pray before you discipline.
 - God will show you how to discipline each child.
 - When you discipline, keep your children close to you.
 - When God disciplines us, He doesn't send us away. He brings us close.

WHEN YOU SEE A COUPLE IN MINISTRY GET THE TENSION RIGHT, WHAT ARE THEY DOING RIGHT?

- Jonathan said he wants his team to take their days off.
 - He wants them to have time to rest.
- He wants them to take their family on the journey (of ministry) with them.
- He wants ministry to be an addition to their life, not a subtraction.
 - That starts in their personal time with the Lord.
 - Don't come into work without spending time with the Lord.
 - God makes your words so much more effective.
 - When you spend time with the Lord, He gives you an anointing.
 - That anointing makes your words effective.
 - When your words are not effective you'll become angry.
- In ministry, your family matters.
 - Ministering to your family is a part of your job description.
