Biblical Worldviews Matter

- You can have a church that's assembled but not aligned.
- A Biblical Worldview is how someone views the world.
 - It's the beliefs, values, and experiences that shape your approach to life.
 - Our perception of reality.
- Ask yourself, "Is what I believe Biblical?"
- Social media has evolved so that we can believe the opinions of a person without any idea of what their life is actually like.
- Your worldview tints the way you see the world and permeates into everything.
- It's the Kingdom of God versus the kingdom of this world.
- We have to learn, as believers, to sift through every truth claim that comes our way.
 - Ask, "Is this Biblical?"

HOW WOULD SOMEONE KNOW IF A LEADER'S WORLDVIEW IS BIBLICAL?

- It starts with knowing the Bible.
- And accessing the Holy Spirit.
- Put the views side by side with Biblical truth and see if they line up with the end goal being the same.
- Go back to the cannon of historic Christian values.
 - It's not just reading today's version of Christianity but going back to the origins.

WHAT DOES THE NEED TO STAND FOR TRUTH MEAN?

- 1 Timothy 3:15 "... you will know how people ought to conduct themselves in God's household, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of the truth."
- The church being a beacon of light in the world requires speaking the truth.
 - Not only in teaching and preaching but in living and discipleship.
 - The church can do a better job of directing where to go and how to learn and live the truth.
- We as the church get to promote the best news on earth.
 - The gospel is the most inclusive of any ideology that exists.
 - In that everyone is invited.
 - But it is also exclusive.
 - If you don't believe Jesus Christ is the leader, Lord, the Son of God, He did die on the cross, and He did raise from the dead for us, then you are excluded.

HOW DO WE NAVIGATE OUR FEELINGS OF HOW OUR PASTOR PREACHES ON CONTROVERSIAL SUBJECTS?

- If you can't align with your leader, you're more of a poison than a help.
 - You can be in disagreement and still find alignment.
 - If you can't find alignment, you need to start a conversation.
 - Find a mentor and have a conversation. Or with your pastor.
 - Go in with honor and questions.
