- He started out of personal frustration to help people in their local church interact with their church's content more easily.

HOW DO YOU SEE CHURCHES NOW STARTING TO USE AI TOOLS WELL?

- The church should start by asking:
 - How am I communicating on social media/with our staff?
 - How can I create content using some sort of base informational data set that's been created?
 - How can we use AI to amplify our pastor's voice?
- Now churches can utilize this AI to reach more people more easily and quickly.

HOW NOT TO USE AI.

- To replace person-to-person ministry.

 - How do we use AI to do something we haven't been able to do yet?
 - What more can we accomplish?

- Ten years from now, we're going to live our lives to be digital first before it is physical.
 - How are we pastoring and leading our people through the changes in the world that this technology is going to bring?
 - We have to start preparing our people.
